CSBC is now in PHASE III of its reopening process. The adult & youth (grades 6 thru 12) Sunday School classes are now meeting in the facility during the regular Sunday School hour. Please contact your Sunday School teacher for specific updates pertaining to your class. We will continue to evaluate the ideal time to begin phase four of implementing Youth and children classes and other church ministries. You'll see below the remaining distinctives still in place.

- 1) Stay seated with your family give adequate space between other groups in your row.
- 2) Please refrain from hugs and handshakes while inside the facility.
- 3) Until all restrictions are lifted, please continue to be aware that the only available entrance open at 10:30 a.m. will be the vestibule of the sanctuary. However, for those directed to the fellowship hall to worship in our overflow area, we encourage you to please exit out of the side door of the fellowship hall.
- 4) Hand sanitizer and masks are available at all exits for your convenience. Masks are for those who feel they need to wear one.
- 5) There are offering boxes placed in the vestibule and fellowship hall for you to have the option of dropping off your offering after service. You may still give online, mail, or bring it by the office during regular business hours.
- 6) Feel free to use one of the offering envelopes provided in the pew. Remember to take what you touch, and if you use a pen please keep it.
- 7) During the worship service, and until further notice, we will be temporarily postponing all congregational bulletin and offering plate distribution, members' memorial flowers, child care, and a pastoral greeting time before and after worship.
- 8) The deacons are evaluating on a weekly basis when the ideal time will be to reactivate other CSBC Ministries, and these current restrictions will be lifted when that time comes.
